3 **ORDINANCE NO. 19639**

5 AN ORDINANCE introduced by Councilmember Karen Hiller authorizing the sale,
6 consumption and possession of alcoholic liquor at a specified location
7 and time for the Jayhawk Theater event to be held on October 1,
8 2011.

10 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA,
11 KANSAS, that:

12 Section 1. Authorization is given to barricade a portion of 8th Street between
13 Jackson Street and Kansas Avenue on October 1, 2011, between the hours of 10:00 a.m.
14 and 9:00 p.m. Attendance to the celebration is open to the public between these hours.

15 Section 2. The barricaded portion of 8th Street between Jackson Street and
16 Kansas Avenue shall be temporarily removed from the City's right-of-way and exempt from
17 the provisions of K.S.A. 41-719(c). Vendors holding the appropriate license from the State
18 of Kansas to sell alcoholic liquor may in accordance with all applicable state laws and
19 municipal ordinances sell alcoholic liquor in the specific area designated by the division of
20 Alcohol Beverage Control within the barricaded portion of 8th Street between Jackson
21 Street and Kansas Avenue on October 1, 2011, between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 9:00
22 p.m.

23 Section 3. Event attendees may buy, possess and consume alcoholic beverages
24 in the specific area designated by the division of Alcohol Beverage Control within the
25 barricaded portion of 8th Street between Jackson Street and Kansas Avenue on October 1,
26 2011, between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m.

Section 4. The Jayhawk Theater is hereby granted a temporary special event retailers permit to sell, offer, and serve cereal malt beverages for consumption on the premises pursuant to K.S.A. 41-2703, as amended.

Section 5. The Binary Benefit-Jayhawk Theater is hereby approved as a special event as required by K.S.A. 41-2645, as amended.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall be null and void on October 2, 2011.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force after its passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
