8 9	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA,
10	KANSAS, THAT:
11	Section 1. Pursuant to K.S.A. 41-719(d) and TMC 9.15.020(d)(5), the City
12	Council may exempt public property from the prohibitions concerning drinking or
13	consuming alcoholic liquor and cereal malt beverages on public property.
14	Section 2. That, in accordance with such authority, the City exempts the top
15	level of the Crosby Place Parking Garage, located at 108 SW 8 <sup>th</sup> Street, from the
16	prohibition of K.S.A. 41-719(c) and TMC 9.15.020(d). Such exemption is conditioned
17	upon the following:
18	A. The occurrence of an event conducted under the auspices of ARTS
19	Connect Topeka for its Arty Party special event to be held on October 15, 2011,
20	between the hours of 6 p.m. and 11 p.m.;
21	B. Arts Connect Topeka has secured a special event permit pursuant
22	to TMC 12.05.010; and
23	C. Arts Connect Topeka has complied with all the applicable state
24	laws and municipal ordinances concerning alcoholic liquor and cereal malt
25	beverage.
26	Section 3. This Ordinance shall be null and void at midnight on October 15,
27	2011.

28	Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its
29	passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.
