**ORDINANCE NO. 19667**

AN ORDINANCE introduced by Daniel R. Stanley, Interim City Manager, relating to and authorizing Project No. T-861004.00 which provides for the construction of a railroad spur to Kanza Fire Commerce Park, as more specifically described herein.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:

Section 1. That it hereby deems advisable and necessary Improvement Project No. T-861004.00 and also hereby authorizes that the public improvement be made as follows:

A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:

This project is for the design and construction of approximately 3,000 linear feet of rail spur and sidings from the BNSF Railway in the Kanza Fire Commerce Park. Construction will include all rail infrastructure necessary to serve the site.

B. TOTAL PROJECT BUDGET COST:

\$2,153,640.00

C. SOURCE OF FUNDS:
