19	private sources, interest on the funds held in the fund, and any other fund having
20	available resources and legal authority to be so deposited or transferred. All such
21	transfers shall be subject to budget appropriations and shall be specifically authorized
22	by resolution of the city council. All expenditures from the fund shall only be for the
23	purpose stated in this section and shall only be made upon approval by the city
24	manager.
