5 AN ORDINANCE introduced by Daniel R. Stanley, Interim City Manager, amending
6 City of Topeka Code § 10.10.200, concerning the adoption of the
7 Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices and specifically
8 repealing said original section.

10 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY THE CITY OF TOPEKA:

12 Section 1. That section 10.10.200, Uniform traffic manual adopted, of The
13 Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

14 **Uniform traffic manual adopted.**

15 (a) The Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways,
16 ~~2003~~2009 Edition, hereinafter referred to as "MUTCD," approved by the Federal
17 Highway Administrator ~~as the National Standard in accordance with Title 23, U.S. Code,~~
18 ~~Sections 109(d), 114(a), 217, 315 and 402(a), 23 CFR 655 and 49 CFR 1.48(b)(8),~~
19 ~~1.48(b)(33), and 1.48(c)(2),~~ is adopted by reference and made a part of this title as if
20 fully set out in this section; provided, however, that the lawful or designated authority
21 empowered to make changes in sign sizes or other deviations as set forth in the manual
22 shall be the city traffic engineer.

23 (b) Not less than one copy of the MUTCD, and of the ordinance or ordinances
24 pertaining thereto, shall be filed with the city clerk and shall be open to inspection and
25 available to the public at all reasonable hours. ~~The police department, municipal judge,~~
26 ~~and all administrative departments of the city charged with the enforcement of such~~
27 ~~devices shall be supplied, at the cost of the city, such number of copies of MUTCD and~~
28 ~~ordinances pertaining thereto as may be deemed necessary.~~

Section 2. That original § 10.10.200 of The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby specifically repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.

Section 4. This ordinance shall supersede all ordinances, resolutions or rules, or portions thereof, which are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 5. Should any section, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.
