4 **ORDINANCE NO. 19709**

6 AN ORDINANCE introduced by Councilmember Karen Hiller authorizing the sale,
7 consumption and possession of alcoholic liquor at a specified location
8 and time for The Office and The Celtic Fox on March 17, 2012
9 pursuant to K.S.A. 41-719(a)(2) and K.S.A. 41-2645(e)(1)

11 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY
12 OF TOPEKA, KANSAS, that:

13 Section 1. Authorization is given to barricade SW 8th Street between Kansas
14 Avenue and Jackson Street on March 17, 2012, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 11:59
15 p.m. for the celebration of St. Patrick's Day. Attendance to the celebration is open to the
16 public between these hours.

17 Section 2. The barricaded portion of SW 8th Street shall be temporarily removed
18 from the City's right-of-way in accordance with TMC 9.15.020(a) for a special event to be
19 held on March 17, 2012 on SW 8th Street between Kansas Avenue and Jackson Street.
20 Vendors holding the appropriate license from the State of Kansas to sell alcoholic liquor
21 may in accordance with all applicable state laws and municipal ordinances sell alcoholic
22 liquor in the specific area designated by the Division of Alcohol Beverage Control within the
23 barricaded portion of SW 8th Street between Kansas Avenue and Jackson Street on March
24 17, 2012, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 11:59 p.m.

25 Section 3. Event attendees may buy, possess and consume alcoholic beverages
26 in the specific area designated by the Division of Alcohol Beverage Control within the
27 barricaded portion of SW 8th Street between Kansas Avenue and Jackson Street on March
28 17, 2012, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 11:59 p.m.

Section 4. The St. Patrick's Day Celebration is hereby approved by the governing body as a special event as required by K.S.A. 41-2645(e)(1) and K.S.A. 41-719(a)(2).

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be null and void on March 18, 2012.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force after its passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
