10	NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA,		
11	KANSAS, that:		
12	Section 1. Authorization is given to barricade a portion of the 900 block of S.		
13	Kansas Avenue between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 12:00 a.m. for Slash and Bash on May		
14	25 and May 26. Attendance to the celebration is open to the public between these hours.		
15	The Director of Public Works shall determine to what extent the street will be barricaded.		
16	Section 2. The barricaded portion of the 900 block of S. Kansas Avenue shall be		
17	temporarily removed from the City's right-of-way for the special event to be held on May 25		
18	and 26 from 5:00 p.m. to 12:00 a.m. Vendors holding the appropriate license from the		
19	State of Kansas to sell alcoholic liquor may in accordance with all applicable state laws and		
20	municipal ordinances sell alcoholic liquor in the specific area designated by the Division of		
21	Alcohol Beverage Control within the barricaded portion of the 900 block of S. Kansas		
22	Avenue between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 12:00 a.m. for Slash and Bash on May 25 and		
23	26.		
24	Section 3. Event attendees may buy, possess and consume alcoholic beverages		
25	in the specific area designated by the Division of Alcohol Beverage Control within the		
26	barricaded portion of the 900 block of S. Kansas Avenue between the hours of 5:00 p.m.		
27	and 12:00 a.m. for Slash and Bash on May 25 and 26.		

28	Section 4.	Slash and Bash is hereby approved by the governing body as a special	
29	event as required by	/ K.S.A. 41-2645(e)(1) and K.S.A. 41-719(a)(2).	
30	Section 5.	This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force after its passage,	
31	approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
