3 **ORDINANCE NO. 19737**

5 AN ORDINANCE introduced by Councilmember Sylvia Ortiz authorizing the sale,
6 consumption and possession of alcoholic liquor at a specified location
7 and time for a special event pursuant to K.S.A. 41-719(a)(2) and
8 K.S.A. 41-2645(e)(1).

10 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA,
11 KANSAS, that:

12 Section 1. Authorization is given to barricade a portion of SW 22nd Street between
13 SW Buchanan and SW Clay between the hours of 11:00 a.m. on June 16, 2012, and 1:00
14 a.m. on June 17, 2012, for Run for the Money. Attendance to the celebration is open to the
15 public between these hours.

16 Section 2. The barricaded portion of SW 22nd Street between SW Buchanan and
17 SW Clay shall be temporarily removed from the City's right-of-way for the special event to
18 be held on June 16, 2012, from 11:00 a.m. to June 17, 2012, at 1:00 a.m. Vendors holding
19 the appropriate license from the State of Kansas to sell alcoholic liquor may in accordance
20 with all applicable state laws and municipal ordinances sell alcoholic liquor in the specific
21 area designated by the Division of Alcohol Beverage Control within the barricaded portion
22 of SW 22nd Street between SW Buchanan and SW Clay between the hours of 11:00 a.m.
23 on June 16, 2012, and 1:00 a.m. on June 17, 2012, for Run for the Money.

24 Section 3. Event attendees may buy, possess and consume alcoholic beverages
25 in the specific area designated by the Division of Alcohol Beverage Control within the
26 barricaded portion of SW 22nd Street between SW Buchanan and SW Clay between the
27 hours of 11:00 a.m. on June 16, 2012, and 1:00 a.m. on June 17, 2012, for Run for the
28 Money.

Section 4. Run for the Money is hereby approved by the governing body as a special event as required by K.S.A. 41-2645(e)(1) and K.S.A. 41-719(a)(2).

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force after its passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
