3 **ORDINANCE NO. 19746**

5 AN ORDINANCE introduced by Councilmember John Alcala authorizing the sale,  
6 consumption and possession of alcoholic liquor as part of the Fiesta  
7 Mexicana parade and street party at specified locations and times for  
8 a special event pursuant to K.S.A. 41-719(a)(2) and K.S.A. 41-  
9 2645(e)(1).

11 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS, that:

12 Section 1. Authorization is given to barricade a portion of SE 9<sup>th</sup> Street between  
13 SE Quincy and S. Kansas Avenue on July 6, 2012, between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and  
14 11:59 p.m. Attendance to the celebration is open to the public between these hours.  
15 Licensed retailers may sell non-alcoholic commodities or food on July 6, 2012, between the  
16 hours of 5:00 p.m. and 11:59 p.m.

17 Section 2. The barricaded portion of SE 9<sup>th</sup> Street between SE Quincy and S.  
18 Kansas Avenue shall be temporarily removed from the City's right-of-way for the special  
19 event to be held on July 6, 2012 between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 11:59 p.m. Vendors  
20 holding the appropriate license from the State of Kansas to sell alcoholic liquor may in  
21 accordance with all applicable state laws and municipal ordinances sell alcoholic liquor in  
22 the specific area designated by the division of Alcohol Beverage Control within the  
23 barricaded portion of SE 9<sup>th</sup> Street between SE Quincy and S. Kansas Avenue on July 6,  
24 2012, between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 11:59 p.m.

25 Section 3. Event attendees may buy, possess and consume alcoholic beverages  
26 in the specific area designated by the division of Alcohol Beverage Control within the  
27 barricaded portion of SE 9<sup>th</sup> Street between SE Quincy and S. Kansas Avenue on July 6,  
28 2012, between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 11:59 p.m.

Section 4. The Fiesta Mexicana is hereby granted a temporary special event retailers permit to sell, offer, and serve cereal malt beverages for consumption on the premises pursuant to K.S.A. 41-2703, as amended.

Section 5. The Fiesta Mexicana is hereby approved as a special event as required by K.S.A. 41-2645(e)(1) and K.S.A. 41-719(a)(2).

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force after its passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
