7 8	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:
9 10	Section 1. That section 3.55.210, of The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas,
11	is hereby repealed.
12	Transfer of general fund moneys to the arts fund for economic
13	development.
14	(a) Each year the city manager, or his or her designee, shall calculate the
15	amount of the city's pro rata share of tax revenue it would have received from the tax
16	exemptions reduced by the city council under the provisions of TMC 3.55.090(c).
17	(b) The city manager shall, as part of his budget, include the amount of \$100,000
18	as an appropriation to the arts fund for economic development in the city of Topeka.
19	(c) The city council may, in its sole discretion, each year as part of the budget
20	approval process authorize the transfer of general funds to the arts fund in the full
21	amount identified as economic tax exemption savings in the city manager's proposed
22	budget or such lesser amount as the council may authorize.
23	Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its
24	passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.
25	Section 3. This ordinance shall supersede all ordinances, resolutions or rules,
26	or portions thereof, which are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 4. Should any section, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared
invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the validity of this
ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.
