15	p.m. to 6:00 p.m. for the NOTO Blues and BBQ event. Attendance to the celebration is
16	open to the public between these hours.
17	Section 2. The barricaded portion of the sidewalk in front of Weller's Grill & Bar
18	located at 220 N. Independence shall be temporarily removed from the City's right-of-way in
19	accordance with TMC 9.15.020(a) for a special event to be held on September 30, 2012,
20	from 2:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. Vendors holding the appropriate license from the State of
21	Kansas to sell alcoholic liquor may in accordance with all applicable state laws and
22	municipal ordinances sell alcoholic liquor in the specific area designated by the Division of
23	Alcohol Beverage Control within the barricaded portion of the sidewalk in front of Weller's
24	Grill & Bar located at 220 N. Independence on September 30, 2012, from 2:00 p.m. to 6:00
25	p.m.
26	Section 3. Event attendees may buy, possess and consume alcoholic beverages
27	in the specific area designated by the Division of Alcohol Beverage Control within the

28	barricaded portion of the sidewalk in front of Weller's Grill & Bar located at 220 N.
29	Independence on September 30, 2012, from 2:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.
30	Section 4. The NOTO Blues and BBQ is hereby approved by the governing body
31	as a special event as required by K.S.A. 41-2645(e)(1) and K.S.A. 41-719(a)(2).
32	Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force after its passage,
33	approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
