ORDINANCE NO. 19801

AN ORDINANCE introduced by City Manager Jim Colson, amending the "District Map" referred to and made a part of the Zoning Ordinances by Section 18.50.050 of the Topeka Municipal Code (TMC), by providing for certain changes in zoning on property located on a 10 ft. strip of land along the northeastern property line of 2107 SW Crest Drive from "R-1" Single-Family Dwelling District TO "O&I-1" Office and Institutional District. (Z13/1) (Council District No. 8)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:

Section 1. That the "District Map" referred to and made a part of the Zoning Ordinances by Section 18.50.050 of the Topeka Municipal Code (TMC), be and the same is hereby amended, by reclassifying the follow described property:

A part of Lot 2, Block A, Maynard's Subdivision, City of Topeka, Shawnee County, Kansas described as follows: Beginning at the Northeast corner of said Lot; thence Southwesterly along the East line of said lot on a 241.98 foot radius curve right, an arc distance of 9.67 feet, said curve having a long chord bearing S38^O17'27"W (assumed), a distance of 9.67 feet; thence N55^O29'34"W, 71.69 feet; thence N44^O14'58"W, 16.42 feet; thence N12^O25'44"W, 10.44 feet to a point on the Northwesterly line of said lot; thence N77^o34'16"E, 10.35 feet to the common corner with Lot 1, Block A, in said Maynard's Subdivision; thence S50^o12'07"E, 89.37 feet (89.52 feet Plat) to the Point of Beginning. Containing 1245 square feet more or less.

from "R-1" Single-Family Dwelling District TO "O&I-1" Office and Institutional District.

- Section 2. This Ordinance Number shall be fixed upon the "District Map".
- Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
- Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage,
