3 **ORDINANCE NO. 19803**

5 AN ORDINANCE introduced by Councilmember Karen Hiller authorizing the sale,  
6 consumption and possession of alcoholic liquor at a specified location  
7 and times for The Office, The Celtic Fox and ESI LIVE on March 16  
8 and 17, 2013, pursuant to K.S.A. 41-719(a)(2) and K.S.A. 41-  
9 2645(e)(1).

11 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
12 TOPEKA, KANSAS, that:

13 Section 1. Authorization is given to barricade SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street between Kansas  
14 Avenue and Jackson Street on March 16, 2013, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 11:59  
15 p.m. and again on March 17, 2013, from 10:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. for the celebration of St.  
16 Patrick's Day. Attendance to the celebration is open to the public between these hours.

17 Section 2. The barricaded portion of SW 8th Street shall be temporarily removed  
18 from the City's right-of-way in accordance with TMC 9.15.020(a) for a special event to be  
19 held on March 16, 2013, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 11:59 p.m. and again on  
20 March 17, 2013, from 10:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. on SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street between Kansas Avenue  
21 and Jackson Street. Vendors holding the appropriate license from the State of Kansas to  
22 sell alcoholic liquor may in accordance with all applicable state laws and municipal  
23 ordinances sell alcoholic liquor in the specific area designated by the Division of Alcohol  
24 Beverage Control within the barricaded portion of SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street between Kansas Avenue  
25 and Jackson Street on March 16, 2013, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 11:59 p.m. and  
26 again on March 17, 2013, from 10:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.

27 Section 3. Event attendees may buy, possess and consume alcoholic beverages  
28 in the specific area designated by the Division of Alcohol Beverage Control within the

barricaded portion of SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street between Kansas Avenue and Jackson Street on March 16, 2013, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 11:59 p.m. and again on March 17, 2013, from 10:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.

Section 4. The St. Patrick's Day Celebration is hereby approved by the governing body as a special event as required by K.S.A. 41-2645(e)(1) and K.S.A. 41-719(a)(2).

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be null and void on March 18, 2013.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force after its passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
