23	p.m. for the event.			
24	Section 3.	Event attendees may buy, possess and consume alcoholic beverages		
25	in the specific area designated by the Division of Alcohol Beverage Control within the

27	the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 11:59 p.m. for the Speedfest Concert event to be held on May
