42 43	with, and the governing body of the City now finds and determines that the total cost of the			
44	Improvements, including the payment of a portion of the City's outstanding Series 2012-A			
45	Temporary Notes dated September 27, 2012, which are due and payable October 1, 2013, and			
46	related expenses are at least \$9,790,000,00 (the "Improvement Costs") with \$1,813,225,03 of			

46 related expenses are at least \$9,790,000.00 (the "Improvement Costs"), with \$1,813,225.03 of

said Improvement Costs to be paid by the owners of the property within the City benefited by the
Improvements (none of which has been paid into the City Treasury on account of the
Improvements), leaving \$9,790,000.00 to be paid for by the issuance of general obligation
bonds; and

52 WHEREAS, in accordance with all of the foregoing, the City deems it necessary and 53 advisable to issue and sell its General Obligation Bonds, Series 2013-B in the aggregate principal 54 amount of Nine Million Seven Hundred Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$9,790,000) for the purpose 55 of paying the Improvement Costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, SHAWNEE COUNTY, KANSAS:

60 Section 1. That there is hereby authorized and directed to be issued General Obligation Bonds, Series 2013-B of the City in the aggregate principal amount of Nine Million Seven 61 62 Hundred Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$9,790,000) (the "Bonds") for the purpose of paying the Improvement Costs as provided by K.S.A. 12-110c, K.S.A. 12-6a01 et seq., Charter Ordinance 63 64 No. 89 of the City and Article 1 of Chapter 10, Kansas Statutes Annotated, all as amended and other provisions of the laws of the State of Kansas applicable thereto. The Bonds shall be dated 65 66 and bear interest, shall mature and be payable at such times, shall be in such form, shall be subject to redemption and payment prior to the maturity thereof and shall be issued in the manner 67 68 prescribed and subject to the provisions, covenants and agreements set forth in a resolution of the 69 Governing Body of the City adopted the same date as the date of the passage and approval of this 70 Ordinance (the "Resolution").

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Section 2. That the Mayor or Deputy Mayor and City Clerk or Deputy City Clerk are hereby authorized to prepare and execute the Bonds and when so executed, the Bonds shall be registered as required by law and the Governing Body shall annually make provisions for the payment of the principal of, redemption premium, if any, and interest on the Bonds as the same shall become due by levying a tax upon all the taxable property of the City.

Section 3. That the City shall, and the officers, agents and employees of the City are hereby authorized and directed to, take such action and execute such other documents, certificates and instruments as may be necessary or desirable to carry out and comply with the provisions of this Ordinance and to carry out, comply with and perform the duties of the City with respect to the Bonds and the Resolution all as necessary to carry out and give effect to the transaction contemplated hereby and thereby.

85 Section 4. That if any portion or provision of this Ordinance or the Bonds shall for any 86 reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such portion 87 or provisions shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance or the Bonds but 88 this Ordinance and said Bonds shall be construed and enforced as if such illegal or invalid 89 provision had not been contained herein. 90

91 Section 5. That the Bonds shall be issued and sold to the purchaser thereof in accordance
 92 with both their bid for the purchase thereof and the terms and conditions of this Ordinance.
