	Section 1. That section 2.55.040, Duties and responsibilities, of The Code of

15	The commission will:		
16	(a) Support efforts to eliminate prejudice because of race, religion, creed,		
17	color, sex, disability, national origin or ancestry, or age, sexual orientation or gender		
18	identity and further goodwill among all people of the city and promote goodwill		
19	cooperation and conciliation within the city;		
20	(b) Promote and facilitate Town Hall meetings and public forums on issues of		
21	interest and concern to residents of Topeka;		
22	(c) Participate in outreach activities and public education;		
23	(d) Partner with groups that share similar goals;		
24	(e) By February 1st of each year, prepare and submit an annual report to the		
25	city and the city council of the commission's activities, identifying issues and problem		
26	areas within the Topeka community and, after reviewing the performance of the		
27	commission during the year, propose any modifications to this chapter and Chapters		
28	2.80, 2.135 and 9.20 TMC that would improve the effectiveness of the commission and		
29	better fulfill the antidiscrimination policies of the city.		

30	Section 2. That or	iginal § 2.55.040 of The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas,	
31	is hereby specifically repealed.		
32	Section 3. This or	dinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its	
33	passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.		
34	Section 4. This or	dinance shall supersede all ordinances, resolutions or rules,	
35	or portions thereof, which are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance.		
36	Section 5. Should	any section, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared	
37	invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the validity of this
