ORDINANCE NO. 19873

AN ORDINANCE introduced by City Manager Jim Colson, pertaining to an amendment to the Topeka Comprehensive Metropolitan Plan for the Historic Preservation Element (CPA 13/1)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The Comprehensive Plan for the City of Topeka may be adopted by the Governing Body upon the recommendation of the Topeka Planning Commission.

Section 2. Section 18.05.020 of the Topeka Municipal Code lists the elements that may

be included in the Comprehensive Metropolitan Plan, and specifies that the Plan may include a preservation plan element.

Section 3. The City of Topeka Historic Preservation Plan, a copy of which is attached hereto as Attachment A and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein, provides longrange guidance and recommendations for future policies and actions in matters pertaining to the preservation of Topeka's architectural and cultural history, and recommendations on the incorporation of Topeka's history into new development projects, and into specific economic development strategies.

<u>Section 4</u>. The Topeka Comprehensive Metropolitan Plan is hereby amended by the addition of the City of Topeka Historic Preservation Plan as a separate Plan Element.

<u>Section 5</u>. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.
