ORDINANCE NO. 19882

AN ORDINANCE introduced by City Manager Jim Colson, authorizing Improvement Project No. T-291030.00 for Combined Sewer Overflow #7 Rehabilitation, approving cost estimates of the proposed improvements, and doing all other things necessary and incidental thereto, and authorizing the use of utility operation funds, authorizing the publication of the Notice of Intention of the Governing Body of the City of Topeka, Kansas, to issue and sell revenue bonds of said City to make such improvements which constitutes improvements to the municipally owned water, water pollution control, and stormwater utility system of the City of Topeka, Shawnee County, Kansas, pursuant to K.S.A. 10-101 *et seq.* and 10-1201, *et seq.*, and all amendments thereto, authorizing issuance of general obligation bonds to pay the costs of the project which further constitutes a general improvement to the City's waterworks, sanitary and/or stormwater sewage disposal system pursuant to City of Topeka Code § A12-1, and authorizing the borrowing of funds from the KDHE SRF Loan to pay the cost thereof.

WHEREAS, the City is a municipality as defined by K.S.A. 10-101 *et seq.* and 10-1201 *et seq.* and all amendments thereto; and

WHEREAS, the City is authorized by the laws of the State of Kansas to issue and sell revenue bonds of the City for the improvement of its water, water pollution control, and stormwater utility system (the "System") pursuant to K.S.A. 10-1201 *et seq.* and all amendments thereto; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed by the Governing Body of the City to be necessary and advisable that the City to improve its System through the Combined Sewer Overflow #7 Rehabilitation (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the preliminary plans, specifications and cost estimates for the Project heretofore duly prepared and filed in the office of the City Clerk of said City, which estimates show a total cost of the improvements to be approximately three million five hundred thousand dollars (\$3,500,000.00) be approved; and

35 WHEREAS, it is found by the Governing Body that such Project will not cause a
36 duplication of existing utility service furnished by a private utility; and

37 WHEREAS, the City of Topeka, Shawnee County, Kansas, is authorized pursuant to
38 City of Topeka Code § A12-1, to issue general obligation bonds for the purposes of paying
39 for improvement, repair or extension to the City's waterworks system and sanitary and
40 stormwater sewage disposal system; and

41 WHEREAS, the City desires to issue and sell revenue bonds and/or general
42 obligation bonds of the City and/or to borrow funds from the KDHE SRF Loan to fund the
43 cost of the improvements or any combination thereof.

44 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
45 TOPEKA, KANSAS:

46 Section 1. That the estimates of costs of the Project as contained in the project
47 budget, in the total amount of three million five hundred thousand dollars (\$3,500,000.00)
48 which are set out on the project budget attached hereto and on file in the office of the City
49 Clerk of said City, be and the same are hereby approved.

50 Section 2. This project will involve insitu relining for Cured in Place Pipe (CIPP)
51 and manhole rehabilitation of one of the critical pipe links in the sanitary system running
52 from NW Harrison and NW Crane Street to NE River Road and NE Lake Street. This
53 project includes inspection, design, and repairs to address the need to reduce and or
54 eliminate Combined Sewer Overflows (CSO) and Storm-Sewer Overflows (SSO) activities
55 and to stay within the Rehabilitation and CSO initiative as approved by KDHE.

56 Section 3. That notice be given by the Governing Body of the City of its intention
57 to complete the Project in accordance with the plans, specifications and cost estimates and

use utility operation funds, and/or to sell revenue bonds and/or general obligation bonds of the City and/or to borrow funds from the KDHE SRF Loan in a total amount not exceeding three million five hundred thousand dollars (\$3,500,000.00) to pay the cost thereof. Such notice shall be signed by the Mayor and attested by the City Clerk and shall be published in the official City newspaper. Such notice shall describe the nature of the proposed improvements and shall state the amount of revenue and/or general obligation bonds proposed to be issued and/or loan funds to be borrowed, or any combination thereof for the payment of the cost of the project and otherwise, the notice shall be in the form as provided by law.

Section 4. That unless written protests against such proposed improvements signed by not less than twenty percent (20%) of the qualified electors of the City are filed with the City Clerk within fifteen (15) days after publication of the notice herein authorized the City both reasonably expects and intends to finance the costs as hereinbefore described from the proceeds of revenue bonds and/or general obligation bonds and/or loan funds or any combination thereof, payable from the rates, fees and charges of the System. The City does hereby express its official intent to reimburse any expenditures made in connection with the Project from System enterprise fund, or obligations incurred by, on or after the date which is sixty (60) days before the effective date of this Ordinance from the proceeds of its revenue bonds as aforesaid in the maximum principal amount previously described in accordance with U.S. Treasury Regulation 1.150-2. This Ordinance, as the expression of the governing body's official intent regarding the matters described herein, will be available, for public inspection in the City Clerk's office at City Hall during regular business hours of the City.

Section 5. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption by the Governing Body of the City by at least a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the members thereof and publication in the official City newspaper.

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6 NOTICE OF INTENTION of the governing body of the City of Topeka, Kansas, to make
7 improvements under Improvement Project No. T-291030.00
8 which provides for Combined Sewer Overflow #7 Rehabilitation
9 and to use utility operation funds, and to issue and sell revenue
10 bonds of said City pursuant to K.S.A. 10-101 and 10-1201, *et*

13 to borrow funds from the Kansas Department of Health and
14 Environment, or any combination thereof, to pay the cost of the

17 Notice is hereby given that as provided by Ordinance No. 19882 of the City of
18 Topeka, Shawnee County, Kansas, (the "City") that the Governing Body of the City intends
19 to make improvements to the City-owned water, water pollution control, and stormwater
20 utility system (the "System") under Improvement Project No. T-291030.00 which provides
21 for Combined Sewer Overflow #7 Rehabilitation (the "Project").

22 Notice is further given that as provided by Ordinance No. 19882 of the City, the
23 Governing Body of the City intends to issue and sell one or more separate series of
24 revenue bonds of the City pursuant to K.S.A. 10-1201 *et seq.* and all amendments thereto,
25 and/or to issue general obligation bonds pursuant to City of Topeka code § A12-1, and/or to
26 borrow funds from the Kansas Department of Health and Environment State Revolving
27 Loan Fund, or any combination thereof, payable from revenues of the System, in an
28 aggregate principal amount not to exceed three million five hundred thousand dollars
29 (\$3,500,000.00) and to so improve the System and make public improvements to the City
30 by completing the Project.

32 Unless written protests against the proposed Project signed by not less than twenty
33 percent (20%) of the qualified electors of the City are filed with the City Clerk within fifteen
34 (15) days after the publication of this Notice, the Governing Body will proceed in
35 accordance with the intention as set forth above to complete the Project and issue and sell
36 its revenue bonds and/or general obligation bonds and/or borrow funds from the Kansas
37 Department of Health and Environment, payable from revenues of the System as above
38 stated.
