	AN ORDINANCE	introduced by City Manager Jim Colson, amending and authorizing the Project Budget approved by Ordinance No. 19555 for Improvement Project No. T-291015.00 which provides for the Oakland Wastewater Treatment Plant biofilter replacement and providing Notice of Intention regarding the issuance of revenue bonds pursuant to K.S.A. 10-1201 <i>et seq.</i>	
	WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 19555, passed and approved May 3, 2011, authorizing		
13	Improvement Project No. T-291015.00 and issuing the Notice of Intention of the City to sell		
14	revenue bonds in an amount not to exceed one million one hundred thousand dollars		
15	(\$1,100,000.00) for said project; and		
16	WHEREAS,	the project has exceeded the original budgeted cost; thus requiring	
17	approval of the amended project budget by the Governing Body.		
18	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE		
19	CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:		
20	Section 1.	That the budget for Project No. T-291015.00 approved by Ordinance	
21	No. 19555 in the amount of one million one hundred thousand dollars (\$1,100,000.00) is		
22	increased to the amount of one million seven hundred forty-one thousand two hundred		
23	ninety-four dollars	(\$1,741,294.00), as set forth in the revised project budget attached	
24	hereto.		
25	Section 2.	That this project is described as follows:	
26	This project	includes the demolition/replacement of the existing earthen bermed	
27	biofilter structure and wood media system and installation of a new concrete bermed		
28	structure with engineered biofilter media system. This option will provide the optimal level		
29	of odor and contaminant control for the influent Pump Station #73 wetwell, and Headwo		

30 Building including screening facility, grit chambers, grit dewatering facilities, clarifiers, and 31 inlet and outlet structures. This option will also help to reduce corrosive chemicals that 32 negatively impact wastewater maintenance cost and overall operation processes at the 33 Oakland Wastewater Treatment Plant (OWWTP).

34 <u>Section 3</u>. That notice, pursuant to K.S.A.10-1210 and amendments thereto, shall 35 be provided by the Governing Body of its intention to complete the Project in accordance 36 with the revised project budget and to issue revenue bonds to pay the costs. Such notice 37 shall be signed by the Mayor and attested by the City Clerk and shall be published in the 38 official City newspaper. Such notice shall describe the nature of the proposed 39 improvements, the estimated cost and amount of revenue bonds proposed to be issued.

40 <u>Section 4</u>. That the City may commence the improvements described in the 41 revised project budget and issue revenue bonds to pay the costs unless a written protest 42 signed by not less than twenty percent (20%) of the qualified electors of the City is filed 43 with the City Clerk within fifteen (15) days after publication of the Notice of Intention.

44 The City does hereby express its official intent to reimburse any Section 5. 45 expenditures made in connection with the Project from the City's utility funds, or obligations 46 incurred by, on or after the date which is sixty (60) days before the effective date of this 47 Ordinance from the proceeds of its revenue bonds as aforesaid in the maximum principal 48 amount previously described in accordance with U.S. Treasury Regulation 1.150-2. This 49 Ordinance, as the expression of the governing body's official intent regarding the matters 50 described herein, will be posted on the City's web site at www.topeka.org and is also 51 available for public inspection in the City Clerk's office at City Hall during regular business 52 hours of the City.

53	Section 6. That the cost estimate and any other part of the project budget
54	approved by Ordinance No. 19555 which is in conflict with this Ordinance and revised
55	project budget is hereby specifically repealed.
56	Section 7. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its
57	adoption by the Governing Body of the City by at least a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the
58	members thereof and publication in the official City newspaper.
