2 NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ISSUE REVENUE BONDS

3 Notice is hereby given that as provided by Ordinance No. 19937 of the City of
4 Topeka, Kansas, (the "City") that the Governing Body intends to repair, alter,
5 reconstruct, enlarge or improve the City's water, water pollution control, and/or
6 stormwater utility system through Improvement Project No. T-291015.00 (the "Project").
7 The Project will provide for the demolition and replacement of the biofilter at the
8 Oakland Wastewater Treatment Plant. The estimated cost of the Project is \$641,294.00.

9 Notice is further given that the Governing Body intends to issue and sell one or
10 more separate series of revenue bonds of the City pursuant to K.S.A. 10-1201 *et seq.*
11 and amendments thereto in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$641,294.00
12 to pay the costs of the Project.

13 Unless written protests against the Project are signed by not less than twenty
14 percent (20%) of the qualified electors of the City and are filed with the City Clerk within
15 fifteen (15) days after the publication of this Notice, the governing body will proceed in
16 accordance with the intention as set forth above to complete the Project and issue and
17 sell its revenue bonds. If the written protests are sufficient, the Governing Body shall
18 submit the Project and proposed bond issue to the electors of the City at a special
19 election as provided by law.
