10 11 12 13	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS, that:
14	Section 1. Amendments to the Budget incorporated by reference as a part of this
15	Ordinance. The amendments to the operating budget for the City of Topeka, Kansas, for
16	the year 2015 as set forth in a document in the format prescribed by the Director of
17	Accounts and Reports of the Kansas Department of Administration, as required by law,
18	which has been published in a summary format together with a notice of public hearing, is
19	hereby incorporated by reference as a part of this Ordinance with the same force and
20	effect as if it were set forth herein in its entirety.
21	Section 2. Amendments to the Budget approved and adopted. The amendments
22	to the operating budget as described and incorporated by reference in Section 1 above are
23	hereby approved and adopted as amendments to the operating budget for the year 2015.
24	Section 3. Funds appropriated by budget. The amendments to the budget as
25	approved and adopted herein shall constitute and shall be declared to be appropriations for
26	the funds and departments as set forth therein, and the appropriations thus made shall not
27	be used for any other purpose. No money in any fund or fund type shall be used to pay for
28	any indebtedness created in excess of the amount appropriated for such fund or fund type,
29	or for the departments of such fund or fund type as referred to in the operating budget.
30	The appropriations made herein are for the year 2015 and no expenditures shall be

incurred as being authorized by such appropriations prior to January 1, 2015 or

32	subsequent to December 31, 2015.
33	Section 4. Budget amendments. Any further amendment to the operating budget
34	must be approved by the Governing Body and enacted in accordance with the provisions of
35	K.S.A. § 79-2929a.
36	Section 5. As used in this ordinance "fund" is defined as follows:
37	Fund. A fiscal and accounting entity with a self balancing set of accounts in which
38	cash and other financial resources, all related liabilities and residual equities, or balances,
39	and changes therein are recorded and segregated to carry on specific activities or attain
40	certain objectives in accordance with special regulations, restrictions, or limitations.
41	Section 6. The following fund types are authorized:
42	Governmental (or statutory) Fund Type: including General Fund, Special Revenue
43	Funds, Debt Service Funds, and Capital Projects Funds; Proprietary Fund Type: including
44	Enterprise Funds and Internal Service Funds (fixed or flexible); and, Fiduciary Fund Type:
45	including Trust and Agency Funds. This Ordinance applies to all funds as listed on the
46	budget certificate and fund summary adopted and submitted to the county and state.
47	Section 7. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its
48	passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
