8 9	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:
10 11	Section 1. That section 2.25.090, Approval of employment and severance
12	agreements, of The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as
13	follows:
14	Approval of employment and severance agreements.
15	(a) All employment contracts with department heads or appointive officers or
16	employees shall be approved by the city council prior to signature by the city manager.
17	Approval by the governing body shall not be required prior to the city manager signing
18	any for employment contracts of 90 days or less duration or with employees not
19	designated as department headsthat does not follow the department of human
20	resources process for recruitment and selection. Such contracts shall not be subject to
21	the procurement ordinances, Chapter 3.30 TMC.
22	(b) No severance or other payments beyond those earned or otherwise
23	authorized by state or federal law, city ordinance or contract shall be made to a current
24	or former appointive city officer, department head or employee without prior city council
25	authorization by the governing body.
26	Section 2. That original § 2.25.090 of The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas,
27	is hereby specifically repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its
passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.
Section 4. This ordinance shall supersede all ordinances, resolutions or rules,
or portions thereof, which are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance.
Section 5. Should any section, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared
invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the validity of this
ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.
