11	Section 1.	That section 10.20.020, Bicycle Trail, of The Code of the City of	
12	Topeka, Kansas, is	hereby repealed.	
13	Bicycle trail	<u>.</u>	
14	(a) The a	reas described in this section shall be reserved for exclusive use by	
15	bicycles and/or ped	lestrians:	
16	(1)	The top of the levee system known as the Oakland Unit of the	
17	Topeka floc	d protection project, in such areas specifically designated and	
18	marked by a	ppropriate signs, such signs to be installed by the city.	
19	(2) —	The Shunga Bicycle/Pedestrian Trail, in such areas specifically	
20	designated a	and marked by appropriate signs at the trail entrances, such signs to	
21	be installed l	by the city.	
22	(b) No m	otor vehicles shall be driven in the area designated by this section	
23	except authorized (maintenance vehicles of the city. Bicycles shall be ridden only upon	
24	the top of the levee	system and on designated areas of the Shunga Bicycle/Pedestrian	
25	Trail. Bicycles shall	not be ridden on the face of the levee.	
26	Section 2.	That section 10.35.010, Riding on sidewalks regulated, of The	
27	Code of the City of	Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:	
28	Riding on s	i dewalks regulated Definitions.	

29	(a) No person shall ride a bicycle upon a sidewalk within the central business		
30	district.		
31	(b) The traffic engineer is authorized to erect signs on any sidewalk or roadway		
32	prohibiting the riding of bicycles thereon by any person, and when such signs are in		
33	place, it shall be unlawful for any person to disobey such sign.		
34	(c) Whenever any person is riding a bicycle upon a sidewalk, such person shall		
35	yield the right-of-way to any pedestrian, and shall give audible signal before overtaking		
36	and passing such pedestrian.		
37	(d) No person riding a bicycle on a sidewalk shall travel at a speed greater than		
38	is reasonable and prudent under existing conditions.		
39	(e) This section shall not apply to a law enforcement officer engaged in the		
40	performance of his official duties.		
41	As used in this chapter, the following definitions shall apply:		
42	(a) "Bicycle" means every device propelled by human power upon which a		
43	person may ride, having two or three tandem wheels.		
44	(b) "Electric personal assistive mobility device" means a self-balancing two		
45	non-tandem wheeled device, designed to transport only one person, with an electric		
46	propulsion system that limits the maximum speed of the device to 15 miles per hour.		
47	(c) <u>"Pedestrian" means:</u>		
48	(1) any person afoot;		
49	(2) any person in a wheelchair, either manually or mechanically		
50	propelled, or other low powered, mechanically propelled vehicle designed		
51	specifically for use by a physically disabled person; or		

52	(3) any person using an electric personal assistive mobility device.		
53	(d) "Pocket park" means an area for public leisure that may include green		
54	space, educational displays, public art, medallions, sculptures, benches, fountains,		
55	miniature trains, pavilions and statues.		
56	(e) "Public parking facilities" means parking lots and garages owned or		
57	operated by the city.		
58	Section 3. That The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended		
59	by adding a section, to be numbered 10.35.020, which said section reads as follows:		
60	Areas reserved for bicycles and pedestrians.		
61	(a) The areas described in this section shall be reserved for exclusive use by		
62	pedestrians and any person who rides a bicycle, skates or uses roller skates,		
63	skateboards, roller blades or other similar devices :		
64	(1) The top of the levee system known as the Oakland Unit of the		
65	Topeka flood protection project and in such areas specifically designated and		
66	marked by appropriate signage.		
67	(2) Regional multi-use trail segments located within the city and		
68	identified in the Topeka Bikeways Master Plan and amendments thereto.		
69	(b) No motor vehicles shall be operated in the area designated by this section		
70	except vehicles used for governmental purposes.		
71	Section 4. That The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended		
72	by adding a section, to be numbered 10.35.030, which said section reads as follows:		
73	Bicycles, roller skates and skateboards; prohibited areas.		

74	<u>(a)</u>	It shall	I be unlawful for any person to ride a bicycle, skate or use roller
75	skates, skat	<u>eboards</u>	, roller blades, or other similar devices in the following areas:
76		<u>(1)</u>	public sidewalks and pocket parks in an area bounded by 4 th Street,
77	11 th S	Street, S	outhwest Jackson Avenue and Southeast Quincy Avenue; and
78		<u>(2)</u>	public parking facilities.
79	<u>(b)</u>	Any pe	erson who rides a bicycle or uses roller skates, skateboards, roller
80	blades, or of	ther simi	ilar devices on a public sidewalk shall:
81		<u>(1)</u>	yield the right-of-way to pedestrians and give an audible signal
82	<u>befor</u>	e overta	king and passing pedestrians; and
83		<u>(2)</u>	travel at a speed that is reasonable and prudent under existing
84	condi	itions.	
85	<u>(c)</u>	This se	ection shall not apply to a law enforcement officer engaged in the
86	performance	e of offici	ial duties.
87	Section	<u>on 5</u> .	That section 10.60.410, Use of skateboards, roller skates, or
88	bicycles pro	hibited, o	of The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby repealed.
89	Use (of skate	boards, roller skates or bicycles prohibited.
90	lt sha	all be ur	nlawful for any person other than a law enforcement officer in the
91	performance	e of his	official duties to use or operate any skateboard, roller skates or
92	bicycle at ar	ny time \	within any municipal parking stations owned and/or operated by the
93	city. A per	son cor	nvicted of violating this section shall be deemed guilty of a

97	Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its
98	passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.
99	Section 8. This ordinance shall supersede all ordinances, resolutions or rules,
100	or portions thereof, which are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance.
101	Section 9. Should any section, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared
102	invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the validity of this
103	ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.
