	AN ORDINANCE introduced by City Manager Jim Colson, establishing a Community Improvement District (CID) for the Cyrus Hotel located at 912-924 S. Kansas Avenue levying a CID sales tax of one percent (1%) within the CID		
9 10	WHEREAS, pursuant to the Community Improvement District Act, K.S.A. 12-		
11	6a26 through 12-6a36, as amended (the "Act") cities are authorized to establish		
12	Community Improvement Districts ("CID") for economic development purposes; and		
13	WHEREAS, on or about August 2, 2016, the City received a petition from the		
14	owners of record of more than 55% of the land within a proposed CID district ("District")		
15	generally described as the Cyrus Hotel located at 912-924 S. Kansas Avenue and the		
16	persons collectively owning more than 55% by assessed value of the land area within		
17	the proposed District; and		
18	WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 8802 adopted on August 16, 2016 the		
19	City has provided notice that it would hold a public hearing on September 6, 2016, to		
20	consider establishing a CID and make findings necessary therefore; and		
21	WHEREAS, the Governing Body conducted a public hearing on September 6,		
22	2016, to consider establishing the proposed District, all in accordance with the Act; and		
23	WHEREAS, the Act provides that upon the conclusion of the public hearing the		
24	Governing Body may authorize the CID and project therein.		
25	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA,		
26	KANSAS, that:		
27	Section 1. The general nature of the proposed project (Project) to be		
28	constructed within the District shall be known as the Cyrus Hotel, which will include a		

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29 109 room boutique hotel, an event space, restaurant, bar and catering services. 30 Proposed improvements include façade improvements; storefronts; canopy lighting and 31 sign band lighting: asbestos abatement; interior remodels; mechanical plumbing; fire 32 suppression systems; electrical upgrades; HVAC and ductwork replacements and 33 replacements; utilitv upgrades; repair/replacement of repair: roof existina 34 sidewalks/curbs; landscaping; design and engineering legal fees; construction 35 management, vertical construction, administrative costs in establishing and maintaining the District and any other items permitted to be financed within the District under the Act 36 37 and authorized in a Development Agreement.

38 <u>Section 2</u>. The Governing Body finds the District furthers economic 39 development within the City and further finds it advisable and in the City's best interest 40 to establish the District and authorize the project as proposed, subject to a Development 41 Agreement approved by the City Manager.

42 <u>Section 3</u>. The estimated cost of the proposed project within the District is 43 approximately \$24,400,000, the developer has submitted CID eligible costs of 44 \$13,026,086.00.

45 <u>Section 4</u>. The legal description of the District includes three tracts as 46 described herein:

47 TRACT 1:

48 PARCEL 1093104014005000: ORIGINAL TOWN, LOTS 302, 304, 306, 912 S KANSAS
49 AVENUE, TOPEKA, SHAWNEE COUNTY, KANSAS; AND

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51 <u>TRACT 2</u>:

52 PARCEL 1093104014007000: ALL OF LOTS 308 AND 310 AND 312 EXCEPT THE
53 SOUTH 7 INCHES OF THE WEST 75 FEET THEREOF, ON KANSAS AVENUE,
54 (ORIGINAL TOWN), IN THE CITY OF TOPEKA, SHAWNEE COUNTY, KANSAS; AND

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57 PARCEL 1093104014008000: THE SOUTH 7 INCHES OF THE WEST 75 FEET OF

59 OF TOPEKA, SHAWNEE COUNTY, KANSAS.
60 Section 5. A map of the District is attached as Exhibit A.

- 61 <u>Section 6</u>. The method of financing the project is through a CID sales tax. The 62 proposed amount of the CID sales tax to be levied is one percent (1%) which shall be 63 levied upon all sales of tangible personal property at retail or services taxable within the 64 CID district pursuant to the Kansas Retailers' Sales Tax Act.
- 65 <u>Section 7</u>. The City authorizes and hereby levies a one percent (1%) CID
 66 sales tax as described in Section 6.
- 67 <u>Section 8</u>. Upon establishment of this District and prior to the expenditure of 68 any CID revenues the City and Petitioner shall execute a Development Agreement 69 setting forth the terms and conditions for implementation of the District. If the parties fail 70 to execute such Development Agreement within thirty (30) days of establishing the 71 District, the City shall commence action to repeal this ordinance establishing the CID.
- <u>Section 9</u>. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its
 passage by a majority of the Governing Body and publication once in the official City
 newspaper.
- 75 <u>Section 10</u>. After publication, the City Clerk is hereby directed to file a copy of
 76 this ordinance with the Shawnee County Register of Deeds.
- Section 11. The City Clerk is directed to provide the Kansas Department of
 Revenue with a certified copy of this ordinance notifying the Department of the
 establishment of the District and the levy of the CID sales tax.
