10	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:		
11 12	Section 1. The Comprehensive Plan for the City of Topeka may be adopted by the		
13	Governing Body upon the recommendation of the Topeka Planning Commission.		
14	Section 2. Section 18.05.020 of the Topeka Municipal Code lists the elements that may		
15	be included in the Comprehensive Metropolitan Plan, and specifies that the Plan may include		
16	neighborhood plans for all geographic sub-areas of Topeka.		
17	Section 3. The Quinton Heights-Steele Neighborhood Plan, a copy of which is		
18	attached hereto as Attachment A and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein,		
19	provides long-range guidance for the future growth and development of the area generally		
20	bounded by SW 21st Street to the north, SW Western Avenue to the east, SW 27th Street to the		
21	south, and SW Washburn to the west. The Neighborhood Plan sets forth a ten (10) year vision		
22	with goals and strategies relating to land use, housing, historic preservation, parks, infrastructure,		
23	public safety, and community organization in a comprehensive manner that recognizes the desire		
24	to increase the livability of the Quinton Heights-Steele Neighborhood.		
25	<u>Section 4</u> . The Topeka Comprehensive Metropolitan Plan is hereby amended by the		
26	addition of the Quinton Heights-Steele Neighborhood Plan as a separate Plan Element.		
27	Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage,		
28	approval and publication in the official City newspaper.
